



OVERVIEW

Welcome to the 2026 Caerleon Running Club Championship!

As with last year, the championship will be split into 5 smaller championships (Paths) modelled after a God from the Roman Pantheon.

Each of these highlights a different aspect of Club Life and has it's own awards and prizes meaning absolutely anyone in the club is able to achieve greatness!

This guide has been created as an easy reference point to tell you which events are included, how you can score points and explains the scoring systems (which have been tweaked slightly this year following members feedback)



THE PATH OF JUPITER

In the path of Jupiter, there are a wide variety of public races covering a range of distances and terrain types - so there should be something for everyone to enjoy!

Any member who takes part in at least 8 events will earn themselves a Path of Jupiter Medal





Scoring System

In every one of these events, you will score Path of Jupiter points as follows:

1st	50
2nd	42
3rd	35
4th	29
5th	24
6th	20
7th	19
8th	18

From 6th Position
Onwards, the amount of points accrued goes down in intervals of 1

Men & Women are scored separately, so both the first Man and Woman would get 50 points etc.

At the end of the year, the top male and female scorers will win themselves

In the path of Mercury - The God of Travelers, we will be visiting 1 different parkrun event per month.



Any member who takes part in at least 8 events will earn themselves a Path of Mercury Medal

Scoring System

There will once again be a competitive element in The Path of Mercury, however this year there is a twist... Rather than points being awarded on finish position, they will be awarded on your <u>age-graded position!</u>

From 6th Position
Onwards, the amount of points accrued goes down in intervals of 1

Men & Women are scored separately, so both the first Man and Woman would get 50 points etc.

Bonus Events

Each year, Caerleon RC runs at least one Couch to 5k program and these culminate by completing one of our local parkruns in the final session.

There will be no competetive points available at these events, but every club member who attends will earn 35 participation points and a credit towards their medal!





In the path of Vesta - The Goddess of the Home, there will be one internal, free event for members each month on a normal club night

Any member who takes part in at least 8 events will earn themselves a Path of Vesta Medal



Scoring System

In each event, you will earn 35 Participation points for attending, as well as scoring competitive points as follows:

Position	Points
1st	50
2nd	42
3rd	35
4th	29
5th	24
6th	20
7th	19
8th	18

- From 6th Position Onwards, the amount of points accrued goes down in intervals of 1
- For Individual events Men & Women are scored separately, so both the first Man and Woman would get 50 points etc.
- For team events, all team members will earn the same score (eg: every person in the team that gets 1st place would score 50 points)

At the end of the year, the top male and female scorers will win themselves

Vestas Volunteers

Our Internal Events can not take place without some members giving up their runs and volunteering.

To make sure this doesn't come at a detriment to their championship aspirations, any member who volunteers at one of these events will earn points equal to one postion below the last place finisher: e.g. if last place earns 55 points (20 competitive + 35 participation), all volunteers will earn 54



THE PATH OF VENUS

In the path of Venus - The Goddess of Love, the focus is volunteering.

Any member who volunteers at running-related events throughout the year at least 12 times will earn themselves a Path of Venus Medal!



On top of this, every volunteering effort throughout the year will earn you 5 points.

At the end of the year, the top male and female scorers will win themselves

- Volunteering when we host the Caerleon 5
 Miler, Spring Equinox Run (TBC) & our XC
 GLCL Course will earn you 30 volunteer
 points
- During the year we run up to two couch to 5k courses consisting of 18 sessions across 9 weeks. Any members who volunteers at 8 or more of these in one course will earn 30 points

*For the purposes of the championship, Volunteering is limited to "Active Volunteering" i.e. Marshalling, Setting Up, Timekeeping etc. Physical attendance at the event is required



THE PATH OF FAUNUS

As the Roman god of the Wilds, those woo wish to follow the Path of Faunus will need to take part in the Gwent League and GLCL Cross-country Races



Any member who takes part in at least 5 events will earn themselves a Path of Faunus Medal!

In each event, you will score 50 participation points for attending, as well as scoring competitive points as follows:
